Fredericton is the capital of New Brunswick with a CMA population of 94,268 (Greater Fredericton). The city is located in central New Brunswick, along the Saint John River, which flows west to east as it bisects the city. It is the third-largest city in the province. The city has the highest percentage of residents with postsecondary education in the province and the highest per capita income of any New Brunswick city.
