# BURLINGTON TRANSIT ROUTE COVERAGE

Burlington Transit connects with Hamilton Street Railway on the south and west, and **Oakville Transit** on the east. In addition, the **Appleby, Burlington, and Aldershot GO Transit** stations on the **Lakeshore West line** are also connected. The Bus Terminal, located in downtown, close to Lakeshore Road (**Highway 2**), is the main bus terminal and the Greyhound Canada bus stop in Burlington.
